Members of the club must not post on any social media platform, text or email anything that would be classed as bullying, hurtful, insulting, offensive, abusive, threatening, racist, homophobic or sexist. This would go against Carlton Town FC's ethos and rules and can also be against the law.

The club expects you not to post personal comments in relation to the management

of your team, the operation of the club, club officials, match officials, players in your

team and other players in the club, opposition teams' member(s), or any family

members of the above.

Clear breach of these rules may result in a club suspension, expulsion and for serious

matters will be referred to the correct authorities.

Behaviour outside of the club:

As a club member, you are always a representative of the club, even outside match

and training hours.

If you engage in any behaviour which could be considered bullying, abusive,

threatening, racist, sexist, homophobic, hurtful, insulting and/or offensive, you are

breaking the rules of the club, going against the club's ethos and putting the club into
